**Subject: Final rates of concession for the sale of Single Super Phosphate (SSP) fertilizer for the months of August and September 2009 under the guidelines on Concession Scheme No.22011/4/2007-MPR dated 25.8.2008.**

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Department's letter No.22011/4/2007-MPR dated 31.3.2009 and 10.8.2009 regarding continuation of the Concession Scheme for Single Super Phosphate (SSP) upto 30.9.2009. The final rates of concession for the sales of Single Super Phosphate for the months of August and September 2009 shall be as follows under the guidelines No.22011/4/2007-MPR dated 25.8.2008, 31.3.2009 and 10.8.2009.

2. The rates of concession as above are applicable for Powdered, Granulated and Boronated SSP.
3. For SSP manufactured/marketed using both indigenous and imported rock phosphate by any manufacturer/marketer, the rates of concession will be settled in proportion to the production of SSP through use of indigenous and imported rock phosphate respectively.
4. Manufacturers/ marketers of SSP will be entitled to claim and receive their 'On Account'/'Balance' and 'Differential' payments for sale of SSP fertilizer under the revised concession scheme as per the proforma and terms and conditions stipulated vide this Department's letter No.22011/11/2008-MPR dated 16 September 2008.

5. During the period for which the final rates/Base rates are announced above, the MRP of the powdered SSP was Rs. 3400/- PMT. The Manufacturers/marketers of SSP were allowed to charge additional Rs.400/- PMT for Granulated SSP (GSSP) over the MRP of Rs. 3400/- PMT applicable for PSSP. For Boronated SSP (BSSP), manufacturers/ marketers were allowed to charge additional 10% of the MRP of SSP indicated in this Department's letter No. 22011/04/2007- MPR dated 25th August 2008.
