OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub.:- Movement of P&K Fertilizers through coastal shipping – Amendment to the Order dated 25th June 2010- reg.

In continuation to this Department's Orders of even number dated 25th June, 2010, conveying the decision of the Government on movement of subsidised P&K fertilizers through coastal shipping as an additional mode of transportation, the undersigned is directed to say that it has been decided in the Department to restrict the coastal freight under the subsidy regime on the basis of Railways Receipt (RR) including "Peak Season Surcharge" for coastal freight so to bring the coastal freight at par with rail freight. Accordingly Para 11 of Order dated 25th June 2010 notifying the Standard Operating Procedure(SOP) for movement of P&K fertilizers through coastal Shipping may be amended as below:-

"The freight for movement of P&K fertilizers will be restricted to railway charges to the nearest rake point to the final destination or actual freight incurred whichever is less"

2. Other conditions in Standard Operating Procedure for movement of subsidised P&K fertilizers through coastal shipping would remain unchanged.
3. This, issues with the approval of competent authority.
