In continuation of this Department's letter No.22011/13/2007-MPR dated 19.5.2008 announcing the concession rates for the months of October 2007 to February 2008 on the sale/receipt of the above mentioned P&K fertilizers under the Concession Scheme of decontrolled P & K fertilizers for 2007-08, I am directed to say that the base rates of concession for 2008-2009 in respect of DAP (Indigenous), DAP (Imported), MOP, NPK Complexes and MAP shall provisionally be as follows:-



3. The base rates of concession as above will be applicable for 2008-09 with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2008. These rates will be applicable for IFFCO, Kandla unit also.
4. All the manufacturers and importers of P&K fertilizers covered under the Concession scheme will be eligible to claim 'on account' payment of concession on the sales of decontrolled P&K fertilizers made by them at the rate of 85% (90% with Bank Guarantee) of the base rates indicated above.
5. The base rates announced herein will be provisional and will be adjusted as per the decision of the Cabinet.
6. This issues with the approval of the Internal Finance Division of Department of Fertilizers vide their dairy No. 976/AS&FA dated 3.6.2008.


