**Subject: Treatment of Unsold Stock of Single Super Phosphate (SSP) as on 1<sup>st</sup> May 2010,**


Sir,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to say that representation from a number of SSP units as well dealers associations have been received in the Department that due to reduction of MRP of SSP by the SSP units / marketers of SSP w.e.f 1<sup>st</sup> May 2010 under the Nutrient Based Subsidy (NBS) Policy, they are facing difficulties in sale of unsold stock of SSP as on 1<sup>st</sup> May 2010, which bear higher MRP under the previous policy when an ad hoc subsidy of Rs. 2000/ per MT was provided by the Government and MRP was fixed by the SSP manufactures and marketers.

2. To enable the Department to further examine the matter, SSP units are requested to provide the following details, SSP unit wise:
