4. Incremental progress of Talcher and HURL (Gorakhpur, Sindri and Barauni) fertilizer projects during January, 2023.

(A). Revival of Talcher Unit:

Cabinet in its meeting held on 04.08.2011 approved revival of Talcher unit of FCIL through nomination basis by forming a Joint Venture of nominated PSUs by setting up gas-based fertilizer plants of 1.27 MMTPA capacity. Accordingly, a JV company was incorporated as Talcher Fertilizers Ltd. (TFL). Equity of GAIL, RCF & CIL in TFL is 31.85% each & FCIL's is 4.45 %. TFL plant is based on Coal Gasification Technology. The project activities are closely monitored by Department of Fertilizers through monthly review meetings held under the chairmanship of Secretary, (Fertilizers). The overall progress of the TFL project is given as under: -

(B) Revival of Gorakhpur, Sindri and Barauni Units:

Cabinet in its meeting held on 13.07.2016 approved revival of Gorakhpur & Sindri units of FCIL and Barauni unit of HFCL through nomination basis by forming a Joint Venture of nominated PSUs. Accordingly, a JV company was incorporated as Hindustan Urvarak & Rasayan Limited (HURL). Equity of NTPC, IOCL and CIL is 29.67% each whereas in case of FCIL, it is 10.99%. HURL is setting up three Gas based Urea manufacturing units of 1.27 MMTPA capacity each at Gorakhpur, Sindri and Barauni. It may be noted that the Gorakhpur Plant was commissioned on 7th December, 2021. The Barauni & Sindri fertilizers plants has started urea production on 18.10.2022 and 05.11.2022 respectively.

Further, the Secretary (F) along with Joint Secretary (AM), DoF visited Sindri fertilizer plant at Jharkhand on 24.01.2023 to review it status along with other stakeholders. Also, the Hon'ble Minister (C&F) reviewed progress of all 05 revival projects viz. Ramagundam, Gorakhpur, Sindri, Barauni and Talcher on 31.01.2023.

5. Expenditure position:

As against an available budget (B.E) of Rs. 109186.78 Crore for F.Y. 2022-23 and additional budget received under Supplementary grants i.e. 109288.95 crores. Therefore total available budget Rs. 218475.73 crore, expenditure on administration of fertilizer subsidy during January, 2023 was Rs. 25775.74 Crore (Urea: Rs.19794.75 Crore, P&K: Rs.5979.87 Crore & Indian Shipping Subsidies: Rs. 1.12 Crore). Progressive expenditure from April 2022 to January, 2023 was Rs.207450.01 Crore (Urea: Rs.142331.8 Crore, P&K Fertilizers: Rs.65117.09 Crore & Indian Shipping Subsidies: Rs. 1.12 Crore) i.e. 94.95 % of the total allocation.
