Notifications dated 10.5.2011 and 25.5.2011 issued by Department of Agriculture and Cooperation re-defining the SSP and DAP respectively under the FCO.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to say that Department of Agriculture and Cooperation, vide its notification dated 10.5.2011 has redefined SSP under the FCO 1985. Accordingly, the water-soluble phosphates (as P2O5) percent by weight, minimum, has been revised from 16% to 14.5%. The other specifications of SSP, as such, have not been changed.

- 2. Similarly, Department of Agriculture and Cooperation, vide its notification dated 25.5.2011 has also redefined the moisture content by weight, maximum 2.5% instead of the existing 1.5% in DAP (18-46-0) under the FCO, 1985. The other specifications of the DAP have not been changed.
- 3. Department of Fertilizers has taken note of the above under the Nutrient Based Subsidy Policy for decontrolled Phosphatic & Potassic fertilizers, accordingly.
