- ii. Whether Furnace Oil is used as feedstock in the manufacture of fertilizers? If so, the quantity and value of FO sourced domestically by the fertilizer companies during 2012-13, for use as feedstock.
- iii. Quantity and value of Furnace Oil sourced domestically by the fertilizer companies during 2012-13 for use other than as feedstock.
- iv. The proportion of FO per unit of fertilizer (in quantity and value terms) used as feedstock and when use for purposes other than feedstock.

2. It is requested that issues raised by M/s Bharat Petroleum Corporation Ltd. may be examined and your views/comments in the matter together with the information / data referred to in paragraph 1 above may kindly be furnished at an early date.

We have two Refineries one at Ambalamughal, Kochi and other at Mahul, Mumbai which caters to the requirements of the petroleum products in different parts of the country.

We wish to bring to your kind notice differential treatment of 'Furnace Oil (FO) to be used for manufacture of fertilizers' from the perspective of customs duty and the excise duty.

Entry 136 Of the Customs Notification No.12/2012-Customs dated 17-03-2012 exempts both BCD and CVD on the FO imported for use in manufacture of fertilizers. The entry reads as under -
