
Subject:- Analysis of rock phosphates imported from Egypt before manufacturing of SSP as per FCO standard and claiming subsidy under NBS Policy.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Department letter No.19011/10/2013-MPR dated 14<sup>th</sup> November 2013 on the subject mentioned above and extending the continued analysis of Egyptian rock phosphate imported by SSP units by PDIL/FEDO before use in production of SSP for another six months upto March 2014. Taking into account the present quality of Egyptian rock phosphate being imported to India for production of SSP, it has been decided to have the mandatory analysis of all consignments of Egyptian rock phosphate imported to India from two months prior to issue of this letter till further orders.

2. Accordingly, all the SSP units under the NBS Scheme are advised to make a reference to PDIL/FEDO for carrying out analysis of each consignment of Egyptian rock phosphate imported prior to two months from date of this letter under intimation to this Department.
3. The cost of analysis will continue to be borne by the SSP units.
