The undersigned is directed to state that Ammonium Sulphate (AS) produced by FACT and GSFC was under concession scheme w.e.f. July, 2008. Pending a detailed study by Tariff Commission, the concession rates for Ammonium sulphate (AS) was fixed provisionally for the period from July, 2008 to March, 2009 and base rate w.e.f. 1.4.2009. The Tariff Commission after a detailed study submitted its report recommending inter alia the normative cost of production and price adjustment formula. The Government has considered the recommendations of Tariff Commission and accepted the same.
