


Subject : Fixation of final rates of concession for Ammonium Sulphate for the period July, 2008 to March, 2010.

The undersigned is directed to state that Ammonium Sulphate (AS) produced by FACT and GSFC was under concession scheme w.e.f. July, 2008. Pending a detailed study by Tariff Commission, the concession rates for Ammonium sulphate (AS) was fixed provisionally for the period from July, 2008 to March, 2009 and base rate w.e.f. 1.4.2009. The Tariff Commission after a detailed study submitted its report recommending inter alia the normative cost of production and price adjustment formula. The Government has considered the recommendations of Tariff Commission and accepted the same. Accordingly the final rates of concessions for Ammonium Sulphate (AS) produced by FACT and GSFC for the above period are hereby notified as under:-


