
OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Alternative route and rates for movement of fertilizers to Manipur, Tripura, Mizoram and Barak Valley area of Assam during the Mega Block (closure of Lumding-Silcher MG Section from 1.10.2014 to 31.3.2015 for conversion of narrow gauge to broad gauge).

In continuation of the O.M. of even number dated 22.10.2014 on the subject cited above, the undersigned is directed to say that secondary freight and godown expenses are rates as notified in FMS or by the concerned state government agencies viz. Department of Agriculture, Manipur, ASWC and will be reimbursed only when government arrangements are utilized. In case any company/supplier makes supply/ movement through any arrangement other than concerned government, they have to get prior approval of Department of Fertilizers otherwise their claims will not be entertained.

The companies/ suppliers are also advised to stick to the supply plan issued by Department of Fertilizers. Freight subsidy will not be admissible for supply in excess of supply plan issued.

The above mentioned guidelines are in addition to the guidelines mentioned in the O.M. of even number dated 22.10.2014.
