OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub.: Recruitment to the post of Joint Adviser (Fertilizer) by promotion/transfer on deputation (including short-term contract) failing which by direct recruitment in the Department of Fertilizers-Regarding.

The undersigned is directed to say that one post of Joint Adviser (Fertilizer), a Group 'A' Gazetted post of General Central Services, in the pay scale of Rs. 4500-5700/- (Pre-revised according to 4th CPC), revised to PB-4, Rs. 37400-67000 + Grade Pay of Rs. 8700/- is required to be filled in by promotion/transfer on deputation (including short-term contract) failing which by direct recruitment basis from amongst the following:

II. Officers of the Central/State Government/recognised research institutions/Public Sector undertakings autonomous organisations:

- (c) (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis or
(ii) with 5 years regular service in posts in the scale of Rs. 3700-5000 (Pre-revised), revised pay band PB-3 Rs. 15600-39100 + 7600/- Grade Pay or equivalent and

(d) Possessing the following educational qualifications and experience :

Essential :

- (iii) M. Sc. Degree in Chemistry or degree in Chemical Engineering/Technology from a recognised University/Institute or equivalent.
(iv) 12 years experience in project planning/development/project appraisal of chemical industries out of which at least 6 years experience should be in the field of fertilizers.

(Note 1: Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the UPSC in case of candidates otherwise well qualified.)

(Note 2: The qualification (s) regarding experience is/are relaxable at the discretion of UPSC in the case of candidate belonging to Scheduled Castes or Schedule Tribe, if at any stages of selection the UPSC is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisites experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them).

Desirable:

Doctorate degree in Chemistry or Master's degree in Chemical Engineering from a recognized university/institute or equivalent.

II The Departmental Deputy Adviser (Fertilizer) or Joint Director (Technical) with 5 years regular service in the grade will also be considered for appointment to the post along-with other. In case, he is selected for appointment the post shall deemed to have been filled by promotion. The Departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

2. **Period of deputation:**

Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation/Department of the Central Govt. shall ordinarily not exceed 5 years.

3. The maximum age limit for appointment by transfer on deputation (including short-term contract) shall not be exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of application.

4. Pay and allowances and other terms and conditions of the selected officers will be regulated as per instructions contained in the Department of Personnel and Training's OM No. 2/29/91-Estt.(Pay-II) dated 05.01.1994 as amended from time to time.

5. It is requested that particulars in the annexed proforma (in duplicate) of the eligible officers who could be spared in the event of selection may be forwarded to Sh. Rakesh Kumar, Deputy Secretary (Admn.), Department of Fertilizers, Room No.-104, B wing, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi through proper channel within 45 days from the date of publication of this office Memorandum in the Employment News along with their complete and up to date CR dossiers.

6. A certification that no vigilance case is either pending or contemplated against the officer along with certificate of Integrity and certificate that no Major/Minor penalty was imposed during last 10 years may also be sent to this Department.

7. The applications of officers received without the ACRs or with incomplete information/documents will not be entertained. Candidates, who volunteer to be considered for this post, will not be allowed to withdraw their names later on.
