**Sir,**

Please find enclosed a copy of urea supply plan under ECA drawn in pursuance to the deliberations of Zonal Conference for Agriculture Inputs for Kharif 2011 held during February, 2011.

2. This supply plan is issued in exercise of the powers conferred on Government of India under Clause 6 of the Fertilizer (Control) Order, 1985 and Fertilizer Movement (Control) Order, 1973.
3. The distribution of Urea from indigenous production will remain under ECA and NON-ECA in the ratio of 50:50 for Kharif 2011 season.
4. The opening stock of urea in the States/ Union Territories as on 1.4.2011 held by the manufacturers will be sold in the respective States (where these are lying) as NON-ECA under intimation to the Department of Fertilizers. No subsidy is admissible on the opening stock as on 1.4.2011 so sold during Kharif 2011.
