Sub: Analysis of rock phosphates imported from Egypt before manufacturing of SSP as per FCO standard and claiming subsidy under NBS Policy.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to this Department's letter No. 19011/19/2010-MPR dated 10.09.2014 according to which all consignment of Egyptian Rock Phosphate imported by SSP units require analysis by PDIL/FEDO for its P₂O₅ content before used for production of SSP. It has been found that there are confusions with regard to analysis of different consignments imported by a company for its different units and more than one consignment from same vessel. This has been considered and is clarified as under:-

- (a) If any SSP unit imports different quantities of Egyptian rock phosphate having different bills of lading from the same vessel, the PDIL/FEDO will draw only one sample from the entire quantity imported under different bills of lading, for analysis. In case the imports relate to different vessels, then the samples are to be collected for each consignment relating to each vessel.
- (b) If any SSP company imports different quantities of Egyptian Rock Phosphate for its different units even if from the same ship, the PDIL/FEDO will draw samples for each unit separately.
